



>> Download the OpenVPN client configuration zip file from the link provided by Workmates team in excel sheet, like below mentioned sample link.

extract the content in **/home/User/**

>> Install 'network-manager-openvpn-gnome' package.


**For Debian Based OS:**

```
sudo apt-get install network-manager-openvpn-gnome
```


**For RHEL Based OS:**

```
sudo yum install network-manager-openvpn-gnome
```


>> **Right-click Network Manager** in the **System Tray**, select **Edit**:



>> Click **Add**



>> In the dropdown, select to import the vpn config:






>> Select the .ovpn config file from your file system:



>> Once this is setup, **right-click** on **Network Manager > VPN Connections** and select the connection to connect. To disconnect, do the same:
